

**ANTONEA GJAJA KOCKOVIĆ** rođena je u Dubrovniku 1982. Flautu je počela učiti s deset godina u Umjetničkoj školi Luke Sorkočevića kod prof. J. Kakarigija te kroz osnovnu i srednju glazbenu školu osvajala nagrade na državnim natjecanjima. Nakon završene opće gimnazije i srednje glazbene škole upisuje studij flaute na Visokoj školi za glazbenu umjetnost "Ino Mirković", u Lovranu. Školovanje nastavlja na Muzičkoj akademiji u Zagrebu gdje i diplomira 2005. Nakon diplome radi kao profesor flaute u Glazbenoj školi Koper u Sloveniji, kasnije i u Umjetničkoj školi Luke Sorkočevića u Dubrovniku.

Poslijediplomski studij završava 2009. u Parizu, na "Ecole normale de musique de Paris", u klasi prof. dr. P. Y. Artaud-a.

Od 2009. do 2010. usavršava se na CNR Marcel Daddy, u klasi Prof. Georges Alirol-a, flautiste Pariškog simfonijskog orkestra. Za vrijeme boravka u Parizu bavila se pedagoškim radom i bila članicom Orkestra francuskih flauta.

Trenutno je prva flauta Dubrovačkog simfonijskog orkestra, vanjski suradnik u Umjetničkoj školi Luke Sorkočevića te surađuje s raznim komornim ansamblima.

***ANTONEA GJAJA KOCKOVIĆ** was born in Dubrovnik in 1982. She began to study flute at the age of ten in the Arts School with prof. J. Kakarigi and while still in school she won awards at national competitions. After graduating from high school she enrolled at the College of Music " Ino Mirkovic " in Lovran, and continued her studies at the Music Academy in Zagreb where she graduated in 2005. After graduation she worked as a professor of flute at the Music School of Koper in Slovenia, later in Arts School in Dubrovnik. She completed her postgraduate study in 2009 in Paris, at the " Ecole Normale de Musique de Paris " in the class of professor dr P. Y. Artaud.*

*In 2009 and 2010 she studied at the CNR Marcel Daddy, with professor Georges Alirol , a flutist of the Paris Symphony Orchestra. During her stay in Paris, she worked as a teacher and was a member of the French flutes Orchestra.*
